



Class Registration Information *Please read before signing up for a class*

Class sizes are limited, so register early. If a class you are interested in has already filled, please ask to be placed on the waiting list. Cancellations do happen, and if there is enough interest in a class, you may see it on the next schedule. Fabrics must be purchased, washed and ironed before the day of class, unless otherwise noted on your supply list. We'll be happy to assist you with your fabric selections.

Payment for classes secures your registration. Phone, fax, or e-mail registrations are accepted with VISA, MasterCard, Discover or American Express. Supply lists are sent upon receipt of payment, so you will have time to assemble the required materials and supplies before the day of class. Come prepared!

Refund Policy: Refunds or credits for class fees can be made if we are notified at least two weeks before the start of class, or if there is a waiting list and we can find a replacement for you. If we cancel a class due to under-enrollment, you will be given a full refund. This decision is usually made one week before the start of class.
